Kristine Morich's studio is housed in Brooklyn's Old American Can Factory, an industrial complex built in 1886. The factory still churns out products, only these days they're much more aesthetically pleasing, as more than 225 artisans and creative types call this vibrant community home. Morich specializes in mold-making for limited-edition pieces and industrial ceramic production. All her designs are created in porcelain, though Morich strives for a new approach to this decorative and functional material. Inspired by natural landscapes and Japan's aesthetic tradition of food presentation, the vessels in her Landscape series (above, \$45-\$180) can be used in multiples, individually or as chargers for other pieces in the line. Creative director of local marketing, advertising and design company Bungalow Creative, Christopher Huelshorst knows a good idea when he sees it. Huelshorst has been moonlighting of late in the home accessories industry, launching his own line of aromatherapy products called Mood::.

Available to the trade, Mood:: candles and diffusers are meeting with great success among retailers nationwide. Each of the 16 scents in the line is designed—and branded—to evoke a specific feeling, from alive to adventurous, from joyful to racy (shown). The candles are hand-poured and 100 percent soy, which is a cleaner and longer-lasting wax alternative. Standard sizes burn for 50 hours or more; the new 5.5 oz. travel candle burns for 30 hours. Its lightweight and expandable Parametre 3D textile systems serve as innovative, clean and modern partitions that separate without completely closing off a space. Available in eight colors (brown is shown here) and made of 100 percent non-woven polyester, this flexible textile is even UV-treated for exterior use. Industrial-strength magnets supported by anchors make installation—and removal—easy, while custom sizing (up to 14 by 16 feet) permits myriad applications.
